## WILDCATS REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The increase in registration fees that you see below is only a portion of the actual increase that were a result of increased ice cost imposed by the township. WMHA will be funding the remainder of this cost through reserve funds. We will be conducting additional (voluntary) fundraising activities this year.

As well, the old (non-voluntary) fundraising fee of \$20 you have seen the last few years, has now been integrated into the registration fee to better reflect its original purpose - to offset our basic operating costs.

A 10% discount applies for families with 3 or more participants.

The rates listed above now include a \$75 late registration fee.

There is an additional fee of \$75.00 for non-Woolwich residents.

If your child decides in the fall not to play hockey and you have already registered, you will receive a refund. The refund will be pro-rated & a \$20.00 administration fee will be deducted if our season has already started when the player decides to stop playing.

## Shop and Support Fundraising Initiative!

Over the summer months, the WMHA Executive team agreed to pilot the Shop and Support ([www.shopandsupport.ca](http://www.shopandsupport.ca)) fundraising program. Shop and support offers shop cards from over 250 retailers across Canada who are offering a percentage of the purchase back to WMHA (percentages range from store to store, but average between 3-5%). Shop cards such as gas, groceries, pharmacy, department stores, and travel to name a few – stores that people are shopping at for their every day needs.

The Executive team will first purchase their shopping card(s) through this program, and then use the shopping card to pay for their purchase.

### Benefits of using Shop cards

- Everyone can choose the type of shop cards they want to purchase, they are not limited to one retailer or one type of retailer
- Everyone buys gas and groceries each week, this is a consistent way of budgeting and contributing without spending more than your monthly budget
- You don't have to buy something you are not interested in (like calendars or chocolate bars)
- As a club, we are not limited to the funds we can raise to grow our program
- It's a great way to get family and friends involved without asking them to purchase something they don't want or need.

**Note:** If the fundraiser is accepted, it will be adopted at the team level and managed by a parent volunteer for each team. Parents are

incented to purchase cards through this program as this is an easy way to generate money from planned purchases for tournament expenses, including tournament fees, meals, lodging, and other team activities. Only a certain portion of the funds raised will be requested back to the WMHA for using this program– the amount or percentage is still to be determined. Also, it is recommended that parents receive a percentage back from the funds raised as an incentive to use the program. Some organizations offer a 50% rule where parents can earn money off their registration. That's right, a family has the potential to earn back their entire hockey registration just by choosing to use shop cards throughout the hockey season.

### How it works

#### Traditional way of shopping

- Go to the grocery store and pay by debit or credit card
- Go to the gas station and pay by debit or credit card
- Go to the movies and pay by debit or credit card

#### Shop and Support way of shopping

1. Order and pay for your shop cards in advance with debit or credit card that you plan to make a purchase at.
2. Receive your shop cards by courier, mail, or from the fundraising coordinator.
3. Go to the grocery store or the stores you selected on your order and pay using the shop card(s).

## Earning Potential

Average Monthly Groceries for a family of 4	\$600
Average Monthly Gas	\$300
Average monthly spending on gas and groceries	\$900
Average return on gas and groceries: 3%	$\$900 \times 3\% = \$27$
8 months of Shop and Support Program / family	$8 \times \$27 = \$216$
12 months of Shop and Support Program / family	$12 \times \$27 = \$324$
Potential funds raised that Shop and Support is willing to write WMHA a cheque for if 400 families participate	$400 \text{ families} \times \$216 = \mathbf{\$86,400}$ (8 months participation) $400 \text{ families} \times \$324 = \mathbf{\$129,600}$ (12 months participation)
